<b>Where is the construction area?</b>	Construction will occur on Cashio Street between Crescent Heights Boulevard and Alvira Street.
<b>Scheduled work hours</b>	Expected construction hours are: Mon – Fri, 7am – 4pm
<b>What can I expect during construction?</b>	<p><b>Cashio Street between Crescent Heights Boulevard and alleyway west of Crescent Heights Boulevard:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Street will remain closed at all times to through traffic</li> <li>• No turns to or from Cashio Street and Crescent Heights Boulevard</li> <li>• Access to alleyway maintained at all times</li> <li>• No parking anytime</li> <li>• Some noise, dust and vibration as associated with excavation work</li> <li>• Heavy equipment and construction trucks</li> </ul> <p><b>Cashio Street between Alvira Street and alleyway west of Crescent Heights Boulevard:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Street will remain closed to through traffic during construction work hours only; local access to be maintained at all times</li> <li>• Street will be plated and re-opened to through traffic after construction work hours</li> <li>• No turns to eastbound Cashio Street from Alvira Street during construction work hours</li> <li>• No parking during construction work hours; parking available after work hours</li> <li>• Some noise, dust and vibration as associated with excavation work</li> <li>• Heavy equipment and construction trucks</li> </ul>
<b>Is local access impacted?</b>	<p>Through traffic will be maintained at all times for local access between Alvira Street and alleyway.</p> <p>No access anytime to Cashio Street between Crescent Heights Boulevard and alleyway. Driveway access will be maintained for businesses and residents for deliveries and trash pickup; contractor will assist with access as needed.</p> <p>Emergency vehicle access available at all times.</p>
<b>Safety Measures</b> <small>(to protect the public and construction crew)</small>	Appropriate traffic handling measures will be implemented to safely divert traffic through the construction zone. Safety barriers will be used in all construction areas.
