Neighbors United is our Neighborhood Association. It was founded in 1981 as a neighborhood watch club to:

- a) Promote neighborhood pride through beautification, education, maintenance, and personal interaction;
- b) Promote neighborhood security through mutual cooperation, alertness, and watchfulness;
- c) Inform neighbors of current issues of concern and interest to area residents;
- d) Identify priority concerns and address them with appropriate agencies or individuals for resolution;
- e) Network with City, County, State and National officials, and with other associations to keep abreast of issues of mutual concern.

Neighbors United represents more than 900 households in the Faircrest Heights Community. It is bordered by Pico Boulevard on the north, Fairfax Avenue on the east, Guthrie Street (or the Kaiser Permanente Hospital wall) on the south and La Cienega Boulevard on the west.

Neighbors United meets on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of each month, except August, at the Claude Pepper Senior Center, 1762 South La Cienega Boulevard at 7 pm. We invite guest speakers on topics of interest to the community; we hear from our senior lead officers from LAPD's Wilshire Division and our Field Deputy from City Council President Herb Wesson's office at our meetings. You'll have an opportunity to meet and interact with your neighbors, the guests, the officers and council deputy.

Our monthly newsletter shares information of interest to the community and the agenda for our monthly meetings. Digital copies of the newsletter are sent if we have your email address. Otherwise block captains deliver hard copies to neighbors who prefer one. Block captains, stay in touch with neighbors on their block to let us know of their concerns and interests.
